At Harrod Horticultural, we wanted to share our excitement with you about our variety of **NEW RANGES for 2010**. There are plenty of inspirational, imaginative and practical products to help the keen gardener every step of the way and here's a few of the seasonal highlights!

Patio Growing Range Expands

Demand for Harrod Horticultural's in-house designed patio growing products in 2009 far exceeded expectation so it was a natural area to expand the selection of products. For 2010 there are **two new Vegetable Garden Frames** – a **Ladder** (from £54.95) and an **A Frame design** (from £84.95). The frames are triple layered, made from FSC wood and can be used to create a back door **mini allotment**. The removable trays provide the flexibility to start seedlings in the greenhouse and then add to the vegetable frames as the temperature warms. To make watering easier there is an **optional irrigation kit** (£19.95) or **capillary watering insert** (£4.95 each) as well as **seed trays with propagating lids** to protect against frosts.

For the patio with spare wall space there is a vegetable garden frame to hang on the wall. **The Bookshelf Planter** (£69.95) is great for growing herbs, salads, strawberries or tumbling tomatoes and is also made from FSC timber. Wall hanging provides the advantages of shelter, radiated heat from the wall and protection from ground pests.

Raised Bed Riot

Just when you thought the Harrod Horticultural Raised Bed Range was complete, four new products are introduced to enhance the offering further – **Raised Bed Liners** (from £3.95), **PVC/Insect Mesh Vented Covers** (from £39.95) to fit our raised bed crop protection hoops, **Raised Bed Tables** (from £85) and **Manger Raised Planters** (from £110).

Made to fit inside our timber raised beds, the **Raised Bed Liners** add a new dimension to patio growing and are great for small gardens. Raised beds can now be placed on a patio with a liner inside to protect the patio, improve water retention for growing and to neatly contain the growing medium.

The in-house designed **PVC Covers** turn your raised bed into a greenhouse and they have the added benefit of full width insect mesh ventilation panels for the summer months to keep pests out and let rain in. They sit neatly over fitted raised bed hoops for ultimate protection. (Continues overleaf)

Alternatively the planter is available dressed with a picture perfect **willow surround** (from £12.95) to bring a traditional touch to your garden. Or why not try growing potatoes the way commercial growers do all over the world – in **Air-Pot Potato Towers**. The unusual shaped air-pot walls prune the roots to develop the perfect root system, meaning improved water and nutrient take up that leads to a prolific crop of healthy potatoes.
