Meanwhile the **Corner Beds** are great for where a ‘normal’ square or rectangular bed can’t be squeezed. Their triangular 122cm x 122cm x 172cm shape are also available in a series of heights (up to 61cm H) and just like our mini-beds are also available in the 3 timber designs from the main range – Allotment, Standard and Superior. These clever beds are available from £19 (+P&P) but then what price is convenience?
