It combines the beauty of the decorative cage with an extendable design that fits over irregular shaped gardens or over narrow vegetable plots. There's the option to fit the new professional steel wire growing system within the corridor cage too. Designed with the help of the RHS, it gives gardeners a professional solution for growing and training decorative forms of fruit using espalier, fan, cordon or cane techniques.
